<u>Leitourgia</u> - Full, active & conscious participation in the Eucharist that informs full, active & conscious prayer life.

<u>Didache</u> - Learning the Church's teachings and Tradition to become credible witnesses of faith.

<u>Karisma</u> - Discover the personal call to exercise the gifts of the Holy Spirit. <u>Diakonia</u> - Service, esp to the poor.

<u>Evangelismo</u> - Being present, witnessing and proclaiming the love of God.
